TTT - A CATALYST FOR CHANGE.

Transition Town Totnes acts as a catalyst for Totnes to explore how to prepare for and adapt to life beyond cheap oil and gas. Since January 2007 it has;

- Held successful talks and film screenings
- Planted walnut and almond trees in the centre of Totnes
- Run a discussion seminar with Local Councillors on peak oil and climate change
- Appeared on BBC's Farming Today programme, ITV South West and in various papers including the Guardian
- Launched the Totnes Pound, a printed currency currently being accepted by 18 local shops as a pilot until June 1st
- Compiled the Totnes Food Directory, which will be published this summer
- Run more successful Open Space days, this time on Economics, the Arts and the Psychology of Change.
- Begun developing the 'Transition Tales' project for local schools to begin this Autumn.


The momentum being generated in Totnes and the enthusiasm with which it has been received continues to be extraordinary, inspiring others to set up projects modelled on the Totnes experience. The Transition Network a charity set up to support them is being set up with its office in Totnes.

"Transition Town Totnes is creating models for people. It's creating visible demonstrations of how people can live in a satisfactory way in a sustainable manner with identifiable principles and an identifiable way of doing things that will make great change on the impacts we make on the Earth.

We can't proceed without those. If we don't have these kind of models then we don't have anything, because then it's just fantasy. Then it's just us saying "let's do this" and everyone else saying "yeah, but how?" If somebody is showing how, then suddenly you have a picture of how, and then you can set out on that path, try to emulate it. So it is absolutely crucial that these things proceed".


